Dear Members,

As you would be well aware, the club is progressing towards starting the redevelopment of the club.

The builder takes possession of the club Tuesday 1st MARCH 2022 – it is now real.

So that there is a smooth hand over the Board of Management request the following:

- All personal craft (Boards & Skis) need to be removed from the club by Sunday 13th Feb, if there is any craft left behind it will be deemed abandon and disposed of.
- The contents of ALL lockers must be removed by Sunday 20th Feb; any items left behind will be disposed of.
- The last day of access to the FITNESS ROOM will be Wednesday 23rd Feb –
NO EQUIPMENT IS TO BE REMOVED FROM THE FITNESS ROOM WITHOUT THE APPROVAL IN WRITING OF THE PRESIDENT
- The last day of access into the pool and change rooms/showers will be Friday 25th Feb

Council have installed toilet facilities on the southern end of the building and containers are starting to be positioned on the grass area in front of the club. This area will become the operational compound for the Club & Council during the build so that we can continue the patrolling obligations on North Cronulla beach.

Our memorabilia will be packaged and stored offsite by professionals.

Our Historians have found a new home for the duration of the build and will have access to their important documents, that will allow them to continue their important work.

The club has also secured storage space offsite which will be used by the relevant sections for the storage of trailers and other equipment.

THE NEXT MONTH BEFORE CLOSE DOWN

There will be communication of the various activities that will be done around the club preparing for vacating the gear shed and building, this will include various working bees and we encourage the assistance of all members. These dates and times will follow shortly.

THE FUTURE

During the build the club will continue to communicate with members. It will be business as usual without a building, we have plans in place to make the building period as seamless as possible. We encourage all member to re-join when memberships become available and show your continued support of the club. We will continue to focus on our Lifesaving, Education, Training, Surf Sports and Nippers during the building period, all sections are making arrangements as required.

From day one when we started the project, the Board of Management have always tried to keep the membership aware and engaged in the project, we have held many information days and meetings. It is our intention to continue this information flow, our website will be maintained and the Project Phoenix (The Development) page will be updated regularly with milestones as they are reached and information to keep you aware of the progress.

This redevelopment would be one of the biggest ventures ever undertaken by a volunteer organisation, your support to date has been great, now that it has become reality, I know it will be nothing but supportive.
