Pain Management Certificate (Methoxyflurane)

Course Description

The aim of this course is to provide participants with the skills and knowledge to carry and administer Methoxyflurane.

Award

Upon successful completion of this course participants will receive the SLSA Pain Management Certificate.

Course Content

- Principles of pain management
- Basic pain management techniques
- Safety considerations and procedures for administering Methoxyflurane
- Procedures for administering Methoxyflurane
- Documentation completion requirements involved in the use of Methoxyflurane

Entry Requirements

- Participants must be a minimum of 18 years of age on the date of final assessment
- Participants must meet the following SLSA requirements:
 - Hold a current Senior First Aid Certificate
 - Advanced Resuscitation Techniques Certificate

General Information

The duration of the course is approximately 3.5 - 4.5 hours.

Assessment

Assessment is through demonstration, presentation and application of all elements in the workplace. Participants will be required to complete activities that may include role-plays, oral and written questioning, practical demonstrations and performing scenarios.
