Officials are those members responsible for the conduct of sports events within Surf Life Saving. There are a range of different roles undertaken by Officials including referees, starters, judges, recorders and marshals across all of the sport disciplines offered by Surf Life Saving.

To become an Official, you are required to complete a Competition Officials course that is conducted by Surf Life Saving. In order to be Officials you must be a financial member of a Surf Life Saving Club and minimum of 18 years of age. All clubs MUST supply a certain number of Officials per carnival before competitor's can compete. It's fun, social and the best seat in the house at all carnivals. 
