North Cronulla SLSC and Bar staff have the right to ask an intoxicated person to leave the club premises and have the right to refuse to serve alcohol to any person suspected of being intoxicated or becoming intoxicated and also the right to deny entry into clubs premises to a person who is intoxicated.

If asked to leave, patrons have a statutory responsibility (section 77 of the liquor act) to comply with such direction, failure to leave may result in management contacting police for assistance which could lead to a \$550 fine

The Judd Room is not be used when it is closed, opening times are Friday nights 6pm – 10.30pm and Sunday afternoons 3pm – 7pm and also when it is advertised for special events .
